# Ideas from 2009 Beginner Dance Party Leaders Seminar

## **Fraley's Frolic**

Suggested by Bob Riggs Formation: Big Circle of dancers all facing in, no partners Music: Any strongly phrased 64-count music

Circle Left 8; Forward and Back; Circle Right 8; Forward and Back; Clap 3 times, behind back 3 times, In front 5 times; Solo turn to Right in 8; Clap 3 times, behind back 3 times, In front 5 times; Solo turn to Left in 8;

### **Simple Circle**

Suggested by Calvin Campbell Formation: Big Circle of dancers all facing in, no partners Music: Something stirring, He uses "Cry of the Celts" from Riverdance

Circle Left 8; Circle Right 8; Walk in 4, Clap 4; Back away 4, Clap 4;

## Jenny Reel

Unknown choreographer, idea researched by Susan Morris at the Don Armstrong Memorial Dance, May 2002 in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Formation: Several Circles of 3 couples each

Music: Any strongly phrased 64-count music

- ----, -- Circle Left
- ----, -- Circle Right
- ----, -- Dosado Partner
- ----, Right Hand Star Across (3 Level Star, those directly across join hands)
- ----, Lowest Level Pull Thru, Swing
- ----, Middle Level Pull Thru, Swing
- ----, Top Level Pull Thru, Swing
- ----, Promenade to New Circle of Three Couples

### Scatter Threesome by Ted Sannella

This is not a first night dance – determining who moves on the Right and Left Thru is a challenge. Formation: Random lines of 3, a gent with two ladies or a lady with two gents (odd one in middle). Music: Any good jig

- 1-16 Dancers on the left ends of each line lead their line around the hall to find another three.
- 17-24 Right Arm Turn the opposite 1 1/2 to form a line of three on the opposite side.
- 25-32 Lines Forward and Back.
- 33-40 Normal Couples Right and Left Thru (may be on the diagonal).
- 41-48 New lines of three Forward and Back (may omit if necessary to fit music).
- 49-56 Each Line of Three Circle Left.
- 57-64 Break and form a line of three with the odd gendered person in the middle.

### ZERO LINE GET-OUTS (from Draft of "Sight and Module Resolution Systems")

(Simple Set Up is Heads/Sides Lead Right, Circle to a Line)

#### **Basic Zero Line Get-Outs:**

B: Circle Left, LA

- **B:** Flutterwheel and Sweep 1/4, Pass Thru, LA
- B: Flutterwheel, Reverse Flutterwheel and Sweep 1/4, Veer Right, PR
- B: Two Ladies Chain, Ladies Chain back into a PR

B: Pass the Ocean, Girls Trade, Swing Thru, RLG

- B Ext: Pass the Ocean, Split Circulate Twice, RLG
- B: Pass the Ocean, Swing Thru, Boys Run, Chain Down the Line into PR
- B: Pass the Ocean, Swing Thru, Boys Run, Girls Trade, Wheel Around, PR
- B: Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Double Pass Thru, First Couple Go Left, Second Couple Follow, PR

B: Right and Left Thru, Flutterwheel, Reverse Flutterwheel into a PR

- B: Square Thru 4, U Turn Back, RLG
- B: Left Square Thru 4, LA or B: Left Square Thru on 4th hand Box the Gnat, RLG
- **B:** Touch 1/4, Column Circulate, Boys Run, LA (may omit Circulate)
- B: Touch 1/4, Column Circulate, Girls Run, RLG (may omit Circulate)

B Ext: Centers Square Thru 4, Ends LA, All RLG

#### Mainstream Zero Line Get-Outs:

M: Centers Box the Gnat and Slide Thru, LA

- M: Ladies Lead Dixie Style to a Wave, Balance, Left Swing Thru, Girls Run, PR
- M: Pass the Ocean, Ladies Trade, Recycle, Pass Thru, LA

M: Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Centers Swing Thru and Turn Thru, LA

M: Pass Thru, Tag the Line, Leaders U Turn Back, Box the Gnat, RLG

M Ext: Pass Thru, Tag the Line, Cloverleaf, Double Pass Thru, Centers In, Cast Off 3/4, Slide Thru, LA

- M: Pass Thru, Tag the Line, Centers In, Cast Off 3/4, All Circle Left, Ladies In, Men Sashay, LA
- M: Pass Thru, Tag the Line In, Touch 1/4, Boys Run, Pass Thru, LA

M: Pass Thru, Tag the Line In, Turn Thru, Ends Fold, RLG

M: Right and Left Thru, Dixie Style to a Wave, Boys Trade, Girls Circulate, LA
M: Slide Thru, Partner Trade, LA
M: Slide Thru, Square Thru 3, LA
M Ext: Star Thru, Right and Left Thru, Rollaway, Square Thru but on 3 RLG

#### Plus Zero Line Get-Outs:

P: Fan the Top, Swing Thru, RLG

P: Grand Swing Thru, Boys Run, Bend the Line, LA

P: Pass the Ocean, Linear Cycle and Roll, Girls Peel Off, RLG

P: Pass Thru, Bend the Line Twice, Slide Thru Twice and Roll, RLG

P: Pass Thru, Chase Right, Trade and Roll, RLG

P: Pass Thru, Tag the Line, Peel Off and Centers Roll, LA

P: Right and Left Thru, Dixie Style to a Wave, Acey Deucey, LA

- P: Slide Thru, Pass the Ocean, Explode the Wave, LA
- P: Square Thru 3/4, Partner Trade and Roll, RLG
- P: Touch 1/4, Coordinate, Girls Run, LA

P: Touch 1/4 and Roll, Slide Thru, LA
