## **Ideas from Palma Heming**

During an excellent Callers' School I attended a couple of years ago with Jerry Jestin and Tony Oxendine, they addressed this very same idea of choreography needing to be interesting to the dancers.

One point made was that a lot of our dancing tends to be in a clockwise direction, e.g. from boxes or 8 chain thru formation: *right and left thru, veer left, couples circulate, ferris wheel* or from lines: *right and left thru, flutterwheel, sweep ¼, veer left, couples circulate –* and you can think of many other examples. It may be good body flow choreo but it is generally in a clockwise direction.

Change things around a little, e.g. from eight chain thru formation *swing thru, boys run, bend the line, reverse flutterwheel, sweep 1/4, veer right, couples circulate, ferris wheel or* from a two-faced line: *bend the line, left touch ¼, circulate* – and it gives the choreography a whole new feeling.

However, having said this and, with much enthusiasm for my new found concept to try some "different", counter clockwise choreo, and, having met with disaster right out of the gate, I found it is also absolutely necessary, to work the dancers up to this "new" direction/feeling a little at a time – a great source of patter material.

So I sat down and researched a few short modules I could use to get the dancers not only moving in a counter clockwise direction but also to transition between the two directions – modules I could sight call into, use, then sight call out of. I found it was a great exercise to analyze body flow as well as dig into the calls a little more. An attempt at a few examples follows:

- Boxes: Swing Thru, Boys Run, Bend the Line, Reverse Flutterwheel, Sweep 1/4, Veer Right, Couples Circulate, Ferris Wheel, Centers Wheel Around, Veer Left
- Boxes: Swing Thru, Scoot Back, Boys Run, Couples Circulate
- Lines: Right and Left Thru, Dixie Style to a Wave, Boys Trade, Boys Run, Couples Circulate, Left Tag the Line, Face Left, Couples Circulate
- Right-hand Two-faced Lines: Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Left Touch 1/4, Column Circulate, Girls Run, Veer Left
- Left-hand Two-faced Lines: Bend the Line, Dixie Style to a Wave, Left Swing Thru, Boys Circulate, Chain Down the Line, Courtesy Turn 1/4 more (girls in), Couples Circulate
- Static Square: Heads Lead Right, Veer Left, Couples Circulate, Tag the Line, Face Left, Couples Circulate
- Static Square: Heads Pass the Ocean, Extend, Swing Thru, Boys Cross Run, Girls Trade, Girls Run, Couples Circulate

The possibilities are endless, enjoy the challenge!
