### CREATIVE CHOREOGRAPHY

Our October meeting included a session challenging us to create some new uses for various Mainstream moves. Here are some of the results. Note! Use with discretion, some are quite difficult.

## SWING THRU:

Heads Square Thru Two, Pass the Ocean, Centres Swing Thru, Centres of each Four Trade, Girls Swing Thru, Each Four Swing Thru twice, Boys Swing Thru, Centres of each Four Trade, Boys Run, Centre Four Wheel and Deal, Others Bend the Line, Allemande Left

Heads Square Thru Four, Pass the Ocean, Centre Four Swing Thru, Centres of Each Four Trade, Girls Swing Thru, Each Four Swing Thru Twice, Boys Swing Thru, Centres of each four Trade, Boys Run, 4 by 4 Bend the Big Line, 2 by 2 Bend the Little Line, 1 by 1 Bend the Itty-Bitty line, Grand Right and Left

Heads Right and Left Thru, Heads Dixie Style to a Wave, (Starting in the centre) Heads Swing Thru, Head Girls Cross Run, Head Boys Trade, Heads Swing Thru, Extend, Swing Thru, Boys Run, Ferris Wheel, Centre Four Swing Thru, Centres Turn Thru, Allemande Left

All Four Ladies Chain 3/4, All 4 Ladies Chain 3/4 to a Do Paso, hold on and men swing into an Allemande Thar, All 8 Left Swing Thru, Girls Run Left, Promenade

Heads Lead Right, Swing Thru once and a half, Men Run, Promenade

Couples # 1 Lead Right, Couple # 4 Lead Left, Swing Thru, Girls U Turn, Couples Trade, Couples #1 & #2 Wheel and Deal, #3 & #4 Bend the Line, #2 & #4 Partner Trade, Promenade SWING THRU WORKING AS COUPLES: Zero Line, As Couples Swing Thru Twice, Partner Trade, Centre Couples Fold behind End couples, Promenade

Zero Line, As Couples Swing Thru once and a half, Centre Couples Veer Right as End Couples Partner Trade, Promenade

# CROSS RUN:

Zero Line, Right and Left Thru, Pass the Ocean, Men Circulate, Swing Thru, Men Cross Run, Left Allemande full turn

Zero Box, Swing Thru, Men Trade, Swing Thru, Girls Cross Run, Allemande Left

## SPIN THE TOP:

Heads Square Thru, Swing Thru, Men Run, Ferris Wheel, Double Pass Thru, Centres In, Cast Off 3/4, Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Girls Spin the Top, Centres Pass Thru and Cloverleaf, Boys Spin the Top, Boys Pass Thru and Cloverleaf, Girls Pass Thru, Star Thru, Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Dixie Style to Wave, Spin the Top Twice, Girls Run, Girls Trade, Couples Circulate, Ferris Wheel, Pass Thru, Allemande Left

### CLOVERLEAF:

Heads Lead Right, Circle to a line, Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Double Pass Thru, Girls Cloverleaf, Girls Diagonally Double Pass Thru, All Face Right, Bend the Line, Men Pass Thru & Cloverleaf, Girls Pass Thru, Star Thru, Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Square Thru 3/4, Allemande Left

Heads Lead Right, Circle to a Line, Touch 1/4, Leading Lady Cloverleaf, Others Extend, Centre Ladies Hinge and Extend, Out-facers Cloverleaf (left), Others U Turn, Star Thru & California Twirl, Step ahead and Bend Line (Squared up), Heads Touch 1/4, Walk and Dodge, Allemande Left DECEMBER 1994, PAGE 3

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### RECYCLE:

Heads Pass the Ocean, Extend, Recycle, Pass Thru, Trade By, Swing Thru, Recycle, Touch 1/4, Centres Trade, Recycle, Veer Left, Couples Circulate, Half Tag, Single Hinge, Centres Trade, Recycle, Star Thru, Couples Circulate, Veer Right, Trade By, Left Allemande

Sides Lead Right, Veer Left, Half Tag, Recycle, Pass Thru, Outsides Cloverleaf, Centres Pass the Ocean, Extend, Single Hinge, Centres Trade, Recycle, Veer Left, Tag the Line In, Pass the Ocean, Girls Trade, Recycle, Box the Gnat, Grand Right and Left

Heads Pass the Ocean and Recycle, Centres Pass Thru, All Pass the Ocean and Recycle, Touch 1/4, all Action: Leaders Double Pass 8 Circulate, Single Hinge, Centre 4 Recycle, Others Recycle behind them, Double Pass Thru, Leads Separate and Star Thru, Others Trade, (Squared Up)

Heads Rollaway then Pass Thru and Separate Around One to a Line, Ends Pass Thru, Recycle (girls in front), Girls Pass Thru, Touch 1/4, Men Trade and Run, Bend the Line, Ends Pass Thru, Recycle, Girls Swing Thru and Turn Thru, Star Thru, Promenade

Sides Square Thru 2, Touch 1/4, Girls Run, Ends Pass Thru, Recycle (boys in front), Boys Pass Thru, Touch 1/4, Girls Trade and Run, Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Ends Pass Thru, Recycle, Double Pass Thru, Men Trade, Touch 1/4, Recycle, Pass thru, Grand Right and Left, Box the Gnat, Slide Thru at home

#### WAHOO

Starting Formation: Right or Left-Handed Box Circulate Formation. Action: All Circulate one position then turn to face the person beside you (1/4 in toward the centre of the box). Ending Formation: Facing Couples Timing: about 6 beats

DOUBLE YOUR NEIGHBOR Starting: Double Pass Thru Thru, Peel Right and Roll. Trailers Pass Thru, meet the other trailers, Step to a Wave and Arm Turn 3/4. Ending: Left-handed Waves Timing: 10 beats

### FOLLOW THRU

(Currently in the C-1 list) Starting Formation: Right or left-hand Box Circulate Formation Action: In facing dancers Extend and Single Hinge while the out facing dancers do 1/2 of a Box Circulate Ending Formation: Two Faced Line Timing: 4 beats
