b) Second Hand Clothing:

We have 3 tote boxes of clothing temporarily stored on the stage at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church. Dottie has additional clothing.

Ask Laurie if the shop is coming to the Festival. If not perhaps take the second hand clothing. Another idea is to hold a "New to You" dance in the fall or spring.

Breakfast TV is currently taped in the afternoon for the next morning.

June 30th Kerry did a demo at Russell Lake Sobeys. Kerry will do another one there during the "Fall Harvest" event.

Possible opportunity to dance at the Community Health and Fun Fair held at Cole Harbour Place.

Bob has a list of suggestions for ways to promote square dancing. He will send it to Don who will distribute it by e-mail to the club representatives.

The Publicity Panel discussion in Detroit agreed that it seems to be more attractive if the dress code is minimized.

Discussed holding a series of one-time events designed to attract new dancers. Advertise these using the free media possibilities. Maybe try dancing one Wednesday a month beginning middle October. Perhaps find a hall in one of the

Russell Lake Apartments (Bob has a contact named Norman Donovan who lives in Parkland Estates), or in Barry Bendle's in Bedford or at Sackville Heights.

Follow up on homeschooled children.
