# g) Halifax National Festival 2010, Dottie Welch:

- Dancers can attend for one day for \$50 per person paid at the door.

- Raffle tickets are now on sale for three individual items (Queen sized blue and white Quilt, Hand Carved Trout, and Nova Scotia Tartan Wreath), look for tickets at your club or special dances.

- Volunteers needed to assist on the setup day, Wednesday July 28th.

- Plan to participate in the Banner Parade on Thursday morning.

- We need more Fashion Show Models.

- Calling all Nova Scotians to participate in the Opening Ceremonies: wear the attire, march in, welcome our visitors, and dance the first tip.

h) **DANS:** The Square Dance in the schools package is still waiting the okay from DANS.

#### 7. Club Reports

a) **Coordinators**, Mary: Dancing regularly usually with 2 or 3 squares, Sail Into Summer is May 15. There will be some Summer Plus Dances on Mondays.

b) **Lake City Swingers**, Mary: We have 4 new dancers who will be through Basic by the end of the season on May 20. Dancing 7-8 couples recently.

c) Fun Squares: no report

d) MMM / Ocean Waves: Dancing about 2 squares.

e) Tidal Waves: Dancing 1 square.

f) **Sail Sets**, Dottie: Dancing 1-2 squares. The A-1 dancers are still working on the last of the A2 list. No dance on March 16 because of March Break. Advanced Weekend tentatively scheduled to be held in Saint John on May 21 and 22. Season ends on June 1. There will be some Advanced Summer Dancing.

g) **Stardusters**, Pat & Jim: Problems with sickness and physical problems. Dancing about 3 squares. Two couples in class due to graduate in April. Pie Night Fund Raiser for Festival 2010 on the 20th of May.

h) **Timberlea Twirlers**, Bernie: Dancing 2 squares most nights. 50-60's Dance is April 12th.

i) **Dancing Shadows**, Dottie: 3 couples dancing to the CDs from Alex usually on Sunday afternoons at the Crowe's home. We are perfecting a few of the more difficult Phase IV dances.

j) **Fun Time Rounds,** Barry: The class and club started again at the beginning of March.

k) **Contra Time Dancers**, Dottie: Had 54 dancers of all ages out on March 6th. Smokin' Contras danced March 12 and again on March 26. They fill the hall with a youth and energy. Our remaining dances are April 3, May 1 and May 29. All dances at St. Matthias Church, corner of Chebucto and Windsor in Halifax.

# 8. Old Business

a) New Year's Eve 2009: Metro New Year's Eve dance was held on Thursday, 31 December 2009 at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church. Dottie called and Lionel cued. Enjoyed our potluck supper at 7:30 and danced from 9 p.m. to Midnight plus a tip. There were 19 dancers plus the four leaders. Income:  $19 \times 12$  per person = 228 and 8 from the 50/50 draw. Paid 80 to Hall, 60 to each leader. Net profit of 36 to Metro.

b) Heart Fund Dance 2010: On Friday, 26 February 2010 a storm of strong winds and torrential rain forced us to postpone the Heart Dance. We held the dance on Friday, 12 March with 15 musicians and more than 4 squares of dancers (40 people). \$465 was donated to the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Nova Scotia. A thank you note has been sent to Ron Noiles, leader of the Metro Fiddlers. Mary sent a thank you note to North Woodside for the free use of the gym for this benefit dance.

# 9. New Business

#### a) Summer Dancing 2010:

Because of declining attendance and increasing hall costs we are changing the hall to St. Andrews Presbyterian Church. The hall has been booked with Sandy MacDonald, cost is \$30 per night.

Dancing Thursday evenings starting June 3, 2010 and ending August 12, 2010. Note this includes July 1 which is Thursday. No dance on July 29th due to the National Convention.

#### c) Marketing through Halifax National Festival 2010

Spectators are welcome for \$5 per person. We will be advertising wherever we can to bring them in. We will hand out information about where and when New Dancers can participate. Perhaps follow up on Breakfast Television in early September.

We estimate there are currently about 160 active dancers in the Metro Area, of those 114 dance Mainstream on a regular basis which is 70%.
